Word of the Lord 2016

We will have many opportunities to complain in 2016. I hear the Spirit of the Lord say be thankful! A thankful heart and declaration will release the salvation of the Lord on our behalf. Our offering of thanksgiving honors and glorifies the Lord. Arise and Shine with thanksgiving.

Two Biblical Principles for Living with Impact

"Whoso offereth praise (towdah) glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth *his* conversation *aright* will I show the salvation of God" Psalm 50:23 (KJV) (Comment added).

TOWDAH PRAISE: <u>**H8426**</u> = properly an *extension* of the hand, that is, (by implication) *avowal*, or (usually) *adoration*; specifically a *choir* of worshippers: - confession, (sacrifice of) praise, thanks (-giving, offering).

SALVATION: <u>H3468</u> = *liberty*, *deliverance*, *prosperity:* - safety, salvation, saving Salvation comes from the root word: H3467 = avenging, defend, deliver, help, preserve, rescue, be safe, bring (having) salvation, save, get victory.

Biblical Principle

- 1. We must offer the sacrifice of praise.
- 2. We must order our conversation and our ways with prayerful deliberation.

What is a sacrifice of praise?

"Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased" Hebrews 13:15 (NKJV).

- The fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name (order your conversation right).
- Remember to do good, to share and to distribute goods (order our ways with prayerful deliberation).

May the God of Peace Equip YOU!

"Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen" Hebrews 13:20-21 (NIV),

TO EQUIP: $\underline{G2675}$ = to *complete thoroughly*, that is, *repair*, or *adjust:* - fit, frame, mend, (make) perfect (-ly join together), prepare, restore, the setting of a dislocated bone.
