**Enforcing Christ’s Victory**

The finished work of the cross is the only basis for God’s provision for all our needs.

Romans 8:31-32 “What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?”

- God freely gives us all things.

We are translated from one kingdom to another.

Colossians 1:12 -14 “Giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.”

- The finished work of the cross of Jesus
- Kingdom is destination

**Jesus’ death disarmed Satan**

Colossians 2:14-15 “Having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.”

- We cannot achieve righteousness by keeping laws.
- God terminated law of Moses as a means to achieve righteousness

### **The Nature of the Warfare**

2 Corinthians 10:3-4 “For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ

1. War not in physical realm, but the mind
2. Fortresses of the mind: Mainly prejudice and witchcraft
3. Release minds from Satan and bring them into obedience to Christ

Ephesians 6:12 “For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.”

- Satanic hosts in the heavenlies seek to gain control of nations, cities and people.

### **Three main weapons**

1. The Word of God
2. The Name of Jesus
3. The Blood of Jesus

### **How to Overcome the Devil According to God’s Word**

Revelation 12:11 “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb [Jesus Christ], and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.” [That is, they testified to what the Word of God says about the blood of Jesus.]

To overcome = OVERCOME

1. To conquer; to vanquish; to subdue; as, to overcome enemies in battle.
2. To surmount; to get the better of; as, to overcome difficulties or obstacles.

OVERCOME, To gain the superiority; to be victorious.

Definitions from Webster’s American Dictionary of the English Language, 1828.

#### **1. The power of personal testimony**

*We overcome Satan when we testify personally to what the Word of God says the blood of Jesus does for us.*

#### **2. The Blood of Jesus**

a. Redeemed through blood – Ephesians 1:7 “In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.”

*Through the blood of Jesus, I am redeemed out of the hand of the devil.*

b. The blood cleanses as we walk in the light – 1 John 1:7 “But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.”

*While I’m walking in the light, the blood of Jesus is cleansing me,  
now and continually, from all sin.*

c. Justified by His blood – Romans 5:9 “Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.”

*Through the blood of Jesus, I am justified, acquitted, not guilty, reckoned righteous, made righteous, just-as-if-I’d never sinned.*

d. Sanctified by blood of Jesus – Hebrews 13:12 “Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.”

- Separated from sin and Satan’s kingdom
- Partakers of God’s holiness

*Through the blood of Jesus, I am sanctified, made holy, set apart from sin and from Satan’s kingdom and made partaker of God’s holiness.*

**We are Redeemed, Cleansed, Justified and Sanctified by the blood of Jesus.**

3. Not loving our lives unto death

- To do the will of God more important than to stay alive
- Soldiers are eligible to die

Jesus’ work on the cross brought total, eternal, irrevocable defeat of Satan and his kingdom.

Romans 8:1-2 “There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.”
